CHILDREN

When communities suffer, children suffer more than anyone else. A community can be measured by how well children are protected and cared for. Our Children's Summer Camp aims to bring joy into the lives of at-risk children. Children also have a vast body of untapped creativity and energy which can be harnessed to make them leaders of change. Programmes like N'KaNa, Eco-system based leadership, and Children's Incubation House give children the knowledge, skills, and platform to express their ideas and transform their own communities in the ways they believe are necessary.

YOUTH

Our organization is completely volunteer-run and survives on the efforts of former and current university students. We believe in a system of two-way growth, in which we also provide youth with guidance and platforms for their ideas and creative projects, in exchange for their extensive work with at-risk children. We also recognize that certain community issues, such as alcohol use and suicide rates heavily impact youth and we are committed to addressing these problems in our communities, with programmes like our youth helpline.

N'KANA MENTORING

N'KANA (MY SISTER AND BROTHER) IS A MENTORSHIP PROGRAM THAT CONNECTS PROFESSIONALS WITH CHILDREN IN NEED AND RISK.

Our misson is to establish a strong positive relationship that will act as a critical guiding force in the youth's development,helping them to achieve their goals and dreams. Each project relationship consists of a mentee(Child),a Mentor (Proffessional) and a volunteer (college Student). Mentors act as exemplary role models for commitment to education, career decisions and social behavior. Student Volunteers facilitate the mentor-mentee relationship. The identities and dream of our youth are affirmed by the consistent support of mentors, volunteers and donors. To coordinate the initiative effectively a part time fellowship was created and appointed a fellow with stipend. N'KANA has been actively running with 10 children and 10 volunteers. This project was supported by SAPNA FOUNDATION.

STUDENTS MOTIVATION WORKSHOP

MIND HANDLING TECHNIQUES FOR THE GOVERNMENT SCHOOL STUDENTS WHO WERE APPEARING FOR THE PUBLIC EXAM (X ,XI,XII STANDARD).

To promote positive mental health and improve focus on study inspite of many distractions of adolescence, we conducted a workshop for the ninth, tenth, eleventh and twelfth standard students of Kottakuppam higher secondary school on the topic of 'Stress management and Mind handling techniques' to reduce exam fear ,academic stress and to improve attention and focus on studies. The session was facilitated by Ms.Rekha Padmanaban, an Icononic motivational speaker and mental health educator in Tamilnadu. In the same workshop some visual imagery practice, breath exercise-cum-meditation with positive affirmations were taught. Along with that physical, psychological and emotional aspects of sex, reproduction and related mind distractions were educated. The session was observed helpful for the students as well as the teachers.

CONSULTATION MEET ON REDUCING THE BURDEN OF SCHOOL CURRICULUM



Trust for Youth and Child Leadership (TYCL) and Satya Special School jointly organized one-day Puducherry State Consultation meeting on 'Reducing the burden of School Curriculum' at the Sri Aurobindo Ashram Society Conference Hall. The experts have proposed a curriculum that is both child-friendly and education-based rather than examination oriented. The main purpose of this meeting is to suggest measures that would help create a child-centered and friendly education system besides ensuring inclusive and affordable education for impoverished and children with special needs. The suggestions and final report-cum-recommendations have been sent to the NCERT and the Tamil Nadu School Education Department.





JEITHU KATUVOM

eithu Katuvom is a Tamil phrase meaning "win and prove." The Jeithu Katuvom program seeks to instill this kind of motivation 10th,11th and 12th standard students who must take government board exams. We help our students to understand the importance of these exams, provide them with tips to face the exams confidently, and mentor them on preparing for future careers.



Jeithu Katuvom is held three times each year, before the quarterly, half-annual, and annual exams. The program is run in our centers and also at Thanthai Periyar Govt Girls Higher Secondary School in Ariyankuppam, Puducherry. Over 300+ students have participated, and the success of the program is seen in the students' exam scores.

The Annual Status of Education Report (ASER), is the largest citizen-led annual survey of children in rural India. Facilitated by Pratham and conducted every year since 2005, the survey seeks to understand children's status of schooling and basic learning in India. This year (2018) ASER is collaborated with TYCL in order to conduct the survey in primary Government schools which are located in rural part of Puducherry region. The outcome of the survey plays a vital role in education policy input, both nationally and internationally.

YOUTH RESOURCE CENTER

The Youth Resource Center (YRC) offers a range of free services for young people, who can drop in any time for information or assistance. The YRC also offers computer classes and computers for personal use. The YRC aims to provide a space for youth to build their self-confidence, and get the necessary tools to kick-start their careers and lead lives of peace and prosperity.



YOUTH-LED ORGANISATION FOUNDER CIRCLE



TYCL organised "Puducherry Youth -Led Organisation Founders Circle" with the theme of "Care-Knowledge-Share". In which 6 Youth - Led organisation founders participated and shared their knowledge, offered support and seeking support to address their needs. This meeting was a milestone for Youth Helpline to reach young people and initiate collaboration with other like minded organisation.

YOUTH HELPLINE

n the year 2018, we received 288 calls from young people of Puducherry in the age group of 14 to 35 years, which is 257% higher than last year. Out of 288 callers, nearly 50% (141) of them directly benefited from Youth Helpline services. In order to measure the impact of Youth Helpline in Puducherry, we have sourced information from Puducherry State Crime Record Bureau, which highlights a 6.8% reduction in the rate of suicide and a 55% reduction in the rate of suicide attempts in the UT of Puducherry.

The Youth Helpline team directly reached 3000+ youth through college/ school/community/club presentations them on sensitised and positive mental health with the assistance of psychiatrists from the National Mental Health Program, Govt. of Puducherry. We reached 50,000+ youth indirectly through our promotional materials, news adds, events, and targeted campaigns.

PUDUCHERRY GIRLS LEAD GIRLS

The government of Puducherry, Women and Child Development Department, Puducherry State Resource Centre for Women, and Trust for Youth and Child Leadership (TYCL) jointly organized "Puducherry Girls Lead Girls" a holistic selfdefence training program for

Puducherry girls. This was first-ever effort to organize a comprehensive selfdefence training in six different aspects like Physical, Emotional, socio-legal, Sexual, Online and Intellectual self-defence for Puducherry girls in the age group of 18-25 years. The Puducherry Girls Lead Girls program drastically improved girls' self-esteem and courage, and their skills in setting boundaries, dealing with conflict, de-escalating violence and preventive techniques. Trust for Youth and Child Leadership has developed a Holistic Self-Defence Curriculum with the support of external experts. The curriculum consists of physical, emotional, online, intellectual self-defence, social knowledge building, socio-legal skills development. Puducherry Girls Lead Girls was held from 21-May-2018 to 25-May-2018 at Co-operative College of Education, Puducherry.


OUTCOME AND IMPACT

The pre and post-tests were done to measure the impact of the training program. The program developed fifty-six girls' self-esteem and courage, and build their skills in setting boundaries, dealing with conflict, de-escalating violence and face the situation with confidence. TYCL have taken an effort to identify the real needs and precise expectations of youth and their communities.

In order to fill that development gap, TYCL has initiated to prepare a manifesto from youth's lens towards "Youth Participative Governance" in Puducherry. This process is not to blame or criticize the policital parties and Government. It's purely to understand the needs and expectations of the young people and submit the same to all leading political parties and future Govt. to prevent future challenges of young people of the UT of Puducherry.

We strongly believe that this manifesto will be useful to the political parties and upcoming new government to have a better understanding of young people and their perspective towards society and government to establish "Youth Participative in Governance" in Puducherry with participation of Youth. The Parlimentry election manifesto were submitted to Chief Minister V.Narayanasamy on behalf of Congress Party and N.Rangasamy on behalf of N.R Congress Party.




PUDUCHERRY STATE LEVEL CONSULTATION ON "LOCALIZING UN YOUTH STRATEGY-2030"



TYCL – Youth Helpline has organised Puducherry State - Level Youth Consultation on the theme "Localising UN Youth Strategy 2030" towards holistic youth development in Puducherry. The consultation was focused on Youth Education, Employment, Health, Social Inclusion & Culture, and youth civic & political participation. Thirty local young people from different walks of life had participated and expressed their problems they face in day – to - day life and also shared few ideas to overcome those issues. The consultation helped us to develop a holistic youth action plan for Puducehrry.

PERMANENT RESIDENCE FOR AATHIYAN COMMUNITY PEOPLE



INAGI INITIATIVE

We are re-starting and expanding our INAGI initiative, which uses film to empower underprivileged communities in rural areas. Our Youth Film Club will visit villages and use video equipment to visually capture the Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats (SWOT) of the communities. The films will then be screened in the village at an interactive session to discuss ways to transform weaknesses and threats into strengths and opportunities.



Twenty-two temporary thatched houses were built to have a dignified permanent settlement for the community members in the new plots. Now, every family has their own house to live in. On 29th June 2018 the new village (Bhagath Singh Nagar) was inaugurated by Vanoor Thasildar with all other Government officials. The Govt. came forward to build a permanent Green House to these families in the future. Quality water and electricity connection with streetlight has been installed.

Next Steps -

YCL is planning to connect adult community members with social entrepreneurship associates to ensure a dignified livelihood for them and completely stop them from begging. Adult members will be connected to potential local dignified jobs.

There is a need for a community hall to be built to do a school follow-up (Tuition) with children and livelihood centre for women at the village.


There is no community toilet and open defecation is prevailing in the community. TYCL is also planning to have a community health camp and to construct a toilet to the community members to ensure personal hygiene of the community members.

Governor of Puducherry and the same has been disseminated across Puducherry and Tamil Nadu through likeminded organizations and Government departments.






