





IMPACTED CHILDREN THROUGH PROJECTS AND EVENTS IN 10 YEARS - 7667 CHILDREN






IMPACTED YOUTH THROUGH PROJECTS AND EVENTS IN 10 YEARS- 374335 YOUTHS






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I'm Surath Kumar, I'm a BA sociology graduate from a local government arts college from Puducherry, who was unemployed after graduation. Like the majority vulnerable youth group, I was also clueless about my future and wandering around with distracting temporary jobs. I met Siva anna through a leadership workshop in 2017 and joined TYCL as a volunteer. I got inspired by the founder, volunteers and the works they do for the cause. As a youth volunteer I had learned and benefited a lot from TYCL. I also got motivated to contribute in the way I could but I was not having any proven/recognized resources yet. I was happily volunteering and searching for jobs of my interests.

There came the cyclone Gaja in the Delta region. Knowing that I edit pictures with Mobile applications passionately, I was given the responsibility to create a poster conveying the needs of people who were severely affected by cyclone in 2017. I felt so responsible and made a simple poster serving the purpose. It reached widely and got viral as a result of which we received a truck full of relief materials. I was amazed by the responses of the single poster which made a huge impact. With that spirit I started learning professional designing software's with the support of devices from the youth resource center of TYCL and got a career guidance, short term internship opportunity to an extended fellowship opportunity to groom my skills while working on a cause. This intervention of TYCL has made me a successful designer with the knowledge and experience of more than 5 global designing software's with proven excellence. Also, I am very proud to share that my creations are being used and disseminated in national and international forums. Focusedly the goal finding & Career building were the important milestones I attained in my volunteering journey with TYCL. Words won't be enough to share my heartfelt gratitude. My journey with TYCL will always continue.

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My name is******, My gratitude for the Youth Helpline Counselor from TYCL. I was undergoing a lot of pain due to my interpersonal and familial issues which made me to feel broken and attempt suicide. Fortunately I was rescued by my family and I underwent a painful treatment and got saved. I was still confused and upset mentally and physically. One of my friends referred to the Youth Helpline from which I received empathetic counseling with the non-judgemental listening space when I was so weak. I was listened very calmly and counseled appropriately. I got new insights and motivation to get rid of the bitter experiences and to move on. With proper understanding they followed me up regularly and provided me a space for self reflection which supported me a lot to change my perspectives. I felt so resilient after the sessions and started focusing on my goals for the better future. Now I am successfully pursuing my modeling career and sincerely preparing for the Chartered Accountant. I will strongly suggest all my fellow youngsters not to think of ending their lives when challenges arise. Facing the challenges and seeking support whenever necessary is courage and strength.
